



## School Camps

### General Camp Rules

- Adults accompanying the group are responsible for the participants and discipline between 21:00 at night – 08:00 the next morning.
- Adults accompanying the group are responsible for safety while the group is swimming in the river.
- Each group must bring their own First Aid kit and each participant must bring their own medication. Also bring a vehicle to take people to doctors or hospital.
- No alcohol, drugs or smoking allowed!
- Tuck shop available
- Note: Poor - no cell phone reception.

### Camp Values & Guidelines (To be enforced by teachers or adults accompanying the group.)

- Treat others with respect and dignity.
- The Ethos of the church/ school / organization still applies.
- Focus on the following:
  - Encourage each other – well done!
  - Take responsibility for yourself, start with yourself. Don't blame others.
  - No insults in language, attitude or actions
  - Be committed to your team – be a team player
  - Be vulnerable, ask for help
- Have fun & reach out to others
- Discipline procedure:
  - Level 1 - leader will explain that the learner's actions or attitudes are not acceptable
  - Level 2 - leader will give a time out and again explain why the learner's behavior is not acceptable
  - Level 3 - Camp leader will have a chat with the learner to determine the cause of the behavior and also give the last warning
  - Level 4 - Parents will be called to come and fetch their child and the school / church / organization will also be informed
